DUOLOGY FOR TWO HARPS

Duology highlights in different ways the sonic power and performative diversity of the harp as an instrument with very ancient roots. Based in part on the composition States and Shapes, the strategy is played out differently along the works three sections. The first part is strictly unified, albeit with the instruments in contrary motion almost constantly. The second part achieves a freedom of tonality in an otherwise very typical performance technique of delicate arpeggios. The third part contrast the darkest instrumental colors with utmost brightness in hard and strident attacks in the fourth part, before the piece ends in tights, rolling movements that alternate as they slowly ascend.

Two double-bass bows are needed for the performance of bars 137 through 188.
